THE POISEUILLE GOLD MEDAL

On the front side of the Poiseuille Gold Medal is a portrait of Jean-Léonard-Marie Poiseuille, cast in relief. The portrait was drawn by the late Icelandic artist Nina Tryggvadottir from a photograph, kept in the Archives of the Académie de Médecine in Paris, France. The signature of Poiseuille is cast in relief and placed below the portrait. The name JEAN-LÉONARD-MARIE POISEUILLE, in relief, surrounds the portrait.

On the backside of the Medal, the following citation is engraved:

Surrounding the citation and cast in relief are the words: THE INTERNATIONAL SOCIETY OF BIORHEOLOGY.
