Aim of the Symposium

Throughout the last decades there have been enormous advances in biorheology.
The knowledge of biorheology is now crucial for a better understanding of
diseases and clinical treatments. The aim of the meeting is to set the present
status of the value of new methods in biorheology for theoretical studies or
clinical practice.

Preliminary program

- Three main sessions on macro, micro and molecular techniques in biorheology are planned. The topics of the sessions concern : blood (viscosimeters, filterability, light scattering...), blood vessel, bacteria, mucus, sperm, synovial fluids, skin, bone... (non exhaustive list).

Symposium Proceedings

Preliminary contacts have been for the publication of invited lectures and symposium papers. One copy of the Book of Abstracts and of the Proceedings will be given to each registered person attending the symposium.

SECOND EUROPEAN CONGRESS OF BIOPHARMACEUTICS AND PHARMACOKINETICS

Salamanca, Spain, 24-27 April, 1984

The First European Congress of Biopharmaceutics and Pharmacokinetics took place in Clermont-Ferrand (France) on April 1-3, 1981. It was attended by more than 600 participants from 30 different countries. 231 communications were presented, in addition to 4 plenary lectures and 3 symposia. The lectures and communications have been published 3 months after the Congress.

The success of this First Congress induced the organizers to envisage a second meeting of the same kind. This meeting will be held in April 1984 at the University of Salamanca (Spain). It will extend, as the first one, over 3 days devoted to Biopharmaceutics, Experimental Pharmacokinetics and Clinical Pharmacokinetics respectively. Each day will include a plenary lecture, a symposium on a selected topic, and oral or poster communications. The official languages will be Spanish / French / English / German. There will be a simultaneous translation in Spanish / French / English for the lectures and symposia. A programme for accompanying persons, and post-Congress tours are also foreseen.
