SCOPE: Haemorheology and Thrombosis

SUBJECTS TO BE COVERED: Biorheology of Red Cell Aggregation, Biochemical and Physiological Approach on Blood Rheology and Thrombosis, The Significance of Haemorheological Alteration in Thrombotic Events, Diabetes and Blood Flow Abnormalities, Haemorheological Aspects in Myocardial Ischaemia, Post-surgery Thrombotic and Haemorheological Alterations, Blood Flow Disturbances in Haematologic Diseases, The Significance of Blood Hyperviscosity in the Progress of Peripheral Vasculopathies, Haemorheological Problems in Cerebrovascular Ischaemi Epidemiological Aspects of Blood Hyperviscosity, Haemorheological Abnormalities in Chronic Renal Failure, Haemapheric Management of Hyperviscosity Syndromes and Therapeutic Advances in Haemorheology

ADDRESSED TO: General practitioners and specialists, in particular in Cardiology, Neurology, Vascular Surgery or Angiology, Internal Medicine, Haematology, Obstetrics and Gynecology.

SCIENTIFIC PROGRAMME: The scientific programme includes Plenary Lectures, Free Communications and Poster Sessions (dedicated to special subjects), Satellite Symposia and Joint Meetings.

Plenary Lectures and Free Communications Sessions include exclusively scientific aspects in haemorheological fields.

Satellite Symposia and Joint Meetings are reserved to the presentation and discussion of works in scientific areas in the vicinity of Haemorheology, where a probable coexistence of thromboembolic situations exists.

A particular attention will be given to Satellite Symposia in the diffusion of results with therapeutic implications. On the other hand, Joint Meetings are intended as a forum open to the participation of other clinical specialities and to the collaboration of Societies or scientific groups, in order to debate thromboembolic situations specific to those areas.

Joint Meetings in the following areas are programmed: Paediatrics (Prof. Cordeiro-Ferreira), Neurology (Prof. José Ferro), Pneumology (Prof. M. Freitas e Costa), Cardiology (Prof. Carlos Ribeiro), Haemapheresis (Dr. Sampaio Madahil) and Haematology (Prof. F. Parreira and J. Pina-Cabral).

A Satellite Symposium on Microcirculation and Microangiopathy is already scheduled (chairmen: Prof. P. Souza-Ramalho and Prof. J.A. Esperança Pina)

OFFICIAL LANGUAGES: English will be the official language in Plenary Lectures, Free Communications and Poster Sessions. Portuguese will be used in Satellite Symposia and Joint Meetings.
