

MAKE SURE THE JOURNAL REACHES YOU

This is the last issue of the *ICCA Journal* to appear in 1990. Your membership has formally expired by December 31, 1990. In 1990, you should have received four Journals as due to you under your membership. In order to receive the 1991 Journals, you should subscribe as an ICCA member. The (renewal) fee is now Dutch florins (Hfl.) 50.--, or US \$ 30.-- for those residing in North America. The annual fee, valid for the years 1989-1992 inclusive, has been established by the Triennial Meeting in Edmonton, Alberta, Canada on US \$ 25.--, but due to the continuing fall of the dollar, the Dutch publisher is no longer able to provide four Journals for this dollar price. Therefore, the fee is set to US \$ 30.--. All members who have paid in advance do not have to supply the deficit, because their money has been transferred in time.

We stress that the fee required ought to be *net* to the ICCA, that is, our credit booking, *free of all banking charges*. However, well-intentioned they may be, we often receive checks to the amount of Hfl. 50.-- (or equivalent) on which we are charged for banking fees. Since these currently amount to some one-sixth of this subscription rate, they are an imposition. Hence, we beg you, when remitting a cheque or any other form of payment, to arrange that it should be *net* and *free* of all charges to the recipient, which, after all, is your own ICCA.
