

PROGRAMMERS' REPRESENTATIVE IN ICCA BOARD*The Board of ICCA*

It has been suggested to the Board of the ICCA that currently active chess programmers should have an additional representative on the Board, and this idea has been welcomed enthusiastically. This person would be someone chosen only by the programmers themselves – ICCA members who do not have an active program (as evidenced by participating in a competition during, say, the previous 3 years) would not be able to vote for this person.

The Board of the ICCA intends to propose this idea formally at the next triennial meeting, and at the same time to hold the first election for this post.

In the interim the Board of the ICCA will co-opt a programmer's representative on the basis of an election held during the tournament in Paris.
