Contributions to the Journal of up to 4000 words are welcome in any form Short contributions (2000 - 3000 words) are preferred Longer papers of striking originality and cogency may be considered, provided the authors consent to publication in instalments. Authors are urged to supply full references, including the names and location of publishers and ISBN or ISSN numbers where applicable

While any form is welcome, efficiency of production imposes an editorial preference for some forms usual in electronic communications. The preferred forms are (in that order) Word (version 7 0 or convertible), LaTeX (information on the ICGA LaTeX style file can be found at http://www.cs.unimaas.nl/~donkers/icga) or plain ASCII Contributions can be emailed to journal@icga org

Figures not conveniently accommodated in any of the above formats may be submitted either in PostScript format or as camera-ready hard copy. We urge contributors not to hesitate to submit their material in the form which most clearly represents the authors' wishes as to lay-out and presentation.
