\*\*\*CHAOS' time control techniques proved to be inadequate against human opponents as it lost four games on time. CHAOS displayed a tendency to go berserk in its quiescence search, spending 15+ minutes on one move frequently and sometimes as much as an hour and a half. Its poor performance in this event does not reflect the real caliber of its play, rather an unforeseen programming problem (humans tend to pick the moves CHAOS expects less often than computer opponents).
