Four years ago, the computer team *Future Schach* entered the US Team tournament. (See ICCA Newsletter Vol 3, No 1, July 1980.) This year, *Future Schach* was resurrected. The team members were Belle (2203), Nuchess (2054/4), Bee Bee (1869), and B10 (UNR). Super Constellation served as alternate in case any of the regulars could not play. Cray Blitz was originally going to play second board, but dropped out at the last minute. All of the computers were at the tournament site except Nuchess. The moves for Nuchess were relayed by phone.

The rate of play was 50 moves in 2 hours. There were 172 teams competing.

Synopsis
