The 1986 ACM/IEEE Computer Society Fall Joint Computer Conference will host the 6th World Microcomputer-Chess Championship (WMCC) in addition to hosting the 17th ACM's North American Computer-Chess Championship (NACCC). A fiveround Swiss-style tournament is planned for the ACM's NACCC, beginning with two rounds on Sunday, November 2nd, followed by one round on each of the following three days. The seven-round WMCC will begin Saturday, November 1st and end on November 6th with two rounds played on the first day. The winner of each event will receive a \$ 2,000.— prize; trophies will also be awarded to the top three finishers in each event.

The world's best experimental and commercial computers are expected to compete. In the ACM's NACCC, HITECH (Berliner et al.), BEBE (Scherzer), CRAY BLITZ (Hyatt, Gower and Nelson), and BELLE (Condon and Thompson) are expected to participate and play should be approaching the grandmaster level. The best commercial products, including those from companies in the USA, Great Britain and Germany will provide intense competition in the WMCC. The WMCC will take place during the days while the ACM's NACCC will take place in the evenings.
