It has been brought to the authors’ attention that the formulation of VSL#3[®] may have changed subsequent to its use in the article as published in final form in 2020. For the sake of clarity, the product commercially distributed as VSL#3[®] circa 2016, and as procured by the authors and referred to herein as “VSL#3,” comprised eight strains of lactic acid producing bacteria: *Lactobacillus plantarum*, *Lactobacillus delbrueckii subspecies Bulgaricus*, *Lactobacillus paracasei*, *Lactobacillus acidophilus*, *Bifidobacterium breve*, *Bifidobacterium longum*, *Bifidobacterium infantis*, and *Streptococcus salivarius subspecies thermophilus*. This same formulation is understood to now be commercially available as Visbiome[®].
