


Supplementary Figure 1. Stratified density plots were used to evaluate the distribution of kinematic values in the participants, based on the clinical score given by each rater (ranging from 0 to 4) and the median score given by the 7 raters. Movement velocity is here expressed as degrees/s (Vel^K).



Supplementary Figure 2. Stratified density plots were used to evaluate the distribution of kinematic values in the participants, based on the clinical score given by each rater (ranging from 0 to 4) and the median score given by the 7 raters. Movement rhythm (Rhythm^K) is expressed as coefficient of variation, computed by the standard deviation/mean value of the inter-tap intervals, expresses (with higher CV values representing a lower regularity of repetitive movements).
