ILO Bulletin of Labour Statistics

The *Bulletin of Labour Statistics* is published quarterly, with Supplements in the intervening months. It presents monthly and quarterly series on employment, unemployment, hours of work, wages and consumer prices from national official statistics. A separate edition of the *Bulletin* is published towards the end of each year with the results of the *ILO October Inquiry*, an annual survey of wages and hours of work in 159 occupations and of retail prices for 93 food items. The regular quarterly issues of the *Bulletin* usually include one or more articles of methodological interest in the area of labour statistics.
